Get Everything Out

To begin assembling your bike, remove all foam protective sheets and cable ties and unfold the bike. Lift up the frame quick release and open the front frame (1A).

You should be able to hear it click open. Once clicked, lock the quick release (1B).





Open the folding joint then insert the stem pillar into the fork tube up to the minimum insertion line marked on the pillar (2A).

Face the handlebar stem forward, then tighten the stem pillar bolts to a torque requirement of or 17–19 N·m (2B).

Close the quick release to lock the folding stem.

To adjust the handlebar position, please refer to the manual (2C).

If you can move the handlebar forward or backward, the clamp bolts are not tight enough.



The Pedals

Look for the letters "R" or "L" stamped on the pedal spindle (3A).

Thread the pedal marked "R" into the crank arm on the chain side of the bike. Turn and securely tighten the pedal spindle in a clockwise direction with an M15 wrench.

Repeat for pedal marked "L" ensuring you are turning the pedal spindle in an anticlockwise direction.



The Seat

To assemble the saddle, loosen the seat clamp, then insert the seat post into the bicycle frame, making sure that the minimum insertion mark on the seat post is completely inserted into the frame and not visible. At the desired height, tighten the quick release seat post binder bolt securely.

Adjust the seat angle to be parallel to the ground and comfortable for the rider.



The brakes have already been adjusted, however, if they require some tweaking, please follow the instruction manual.

Folding the Electric Bicycle

To fold your electric bike, start with your front frame. Unlock the quick release on the frame, then release it. Lift up the quick release until you hear it unlock, then fold the front frame (5A).

For the handlebar, unlock the locking lever and release it. Then push the bolt to the side and release it from the locking mechanism (5B).

Hold the lever in the pedal, then fold the pedal (5C).

Finally, fold the frame and stem.

And that's it!





Final Check-up

Once you're done assembling the bike, now it's time to do the rounds and check if everything is ok.

Before riding, check if the brakes if they are working to your satisfaction. Check if the seat/handlebar are secure and not moving. Then finally, check the chain and tyres.

Enjoy the ride!





Once the bike is assembled, it is crucial that you go back and retighten the nuts and bolts you secured earlier with a suitable wrench.



Please refer to the manual for battery charging instructions and advice for riding with electric pedal assistance.
